Parental Contribution

Throughout the school year we arrange a variety of extra activities, including FitKids, speech & drama, tennis, soccer, rugby, basketball, Gaelic football, hurling and camogie coaching, swimming lessons, visiting storytellers or theatre, mindfulness, yoga and Irish dancing. For senior classes we also organise team training and enter sports leagues against other local schools in basketball, soccer and Gaelic football, school choir, debating competitions and Quiz Teams. To help us cover the cost of these additional activities, St. Francis NS operates a parental contribution scheme. We ask each child to pay **€25 per per term** (or €75 per year – maximum €150 per family) towards the cost of these activities. Some parents prefer to pay for the full year in one go, and others prefer to pay termly. We rely heavily on these parental contributions from ALL PARENTS to cover the cost of the extra activities.
