Free Primary Schoolbooks Scheme 24/25

For the 2024/25 school year, the Dept. of Education is providing the school with funding to purchase all textbooks, workbooks and copies. This is most welcome funding which we hope will continue into the future and will significantly reduce the cost of returning to school for parents.

Where funding allows, some related classroom resources may also be provided for your child. However, your teacher may require you purchase some specific items relevant to your child's class and these are specified below.

The schoolbooks and workbooks will be on loan and must be returned at the end of the school year, or if the child leaves the school. Please help make sure your child keeps the schoolbooks safe and takes care of them, so they can be used again by another child.

We have a nominal charge of **€50 per pupil** (payable on Aladdin) to cover all classroom expenses related to Arts and Craft materials, photocopying, 24 hour pupil accident insurance (see www.stfrancisns.ie/parents-info/personal-accident-insurance/) and classroom supplies/consumables.

Parental Contribution

Throughout the school year we arrange a variety of extra activities, including FitKids, speech & drama, tennis, soccer, rugby, basketball, Gaelic football, hurling and camogie coaching, swimming lessons (4th & 5th classes), visiting storytellers or theatre, mindfulness, yoga and Irish dancing. For senior classes we also organise team training and enter sports leagues against other local schools in basketball, soccer and Gaelic football, school choir, debating competitions and Quiz Teams. To help us cover the cost of these additional activities, St. Francis NS operates a voluntary parental contribution scheme.
